A knitting workshop with Cat Bordhi

Description: In one lively day, Cat will teach you all you need to know to confidently knit the Wherewithall Vest, a design that flatters many body types and is easily customized to suit your choice of yarn weights and colors. In fact, most people start planning their second one while working on their first! Students will receive a PDF of the pattern in advance.

Homework: Please complete the Tiny Vest tutorial before the workshop, so that class time can be used for custom fitting and planning the details of your full-sized vest. You may use the information in the pattern to choose yarn for your full-size vest, and if you bring it, will be able to get started on it during the workshop. Or, you might bring just one ball of the kind of yarn you plan to use and swatch with it during the workshop, to determine how much you will need.

Travel Note: Please note that traffic to the Vashon Sheepdog Classic can cause ferry delays, Please catch an early boat to ensure you get to the workshop in time. There is ample parking at the Country Store with a free shuttle to all who wish to go to the trials after the workshop.
